Injunction on the National Football League, Inc.
Playoffs of 2013/Civil Complaint

To: The Honorable District Court Judge for the United States

AND NOW COMES, the plaintiff, Daniel L. Spuck, pro se
(I.F.P) and avers the following in support:

1. That on December 29, 2013, The Pittsburgh Steelers
were eliminated from the playoffs, because the defendants
through their employees (game official and instant replay
booth) were negligent and fraudulent when they missed
an illegal alignment by the San Diego Chargers, by having
more than 6 players on the right side of the Football during
the Kansas City kicker success, thus causing him to miss
the Field Goal wide right.

The improper alignment should have been penalized
5 yards and a re-kick should have occurred, but was
not by both game officials and instant replay, whom has
sole availability and required to review plays with
2 minutes or less. The illegal alignment occurred with
8 seconds remaining in the game.

Game Changing result

2. This case before the Court is unlike no

Other because Andy Reid Kansas City Chiefs Coach was unable to challenge the call by way of instant replay by throwing a flag ^(red) with less than 2 minutes, which would have permitted a re-kick thus by making the 3 point conversion would have placed the Pittsburgh Steelers in Playoffs.

Because of the uniqueness and the defendants allowing challenges ^(instant replay) 1 per game if successful the team gets another challenge of an officials incorrect call. It is fraudulent and negligent by the defendants to disallow a challenge with less than two minutes in a football game.

Alternatively, ^{NFL} In overtime the officials took away a touchdown by Kansas City Chiefs on a new rule inserted in regard to helmet coming off prior to player being down. The New rule is improper and unconstitutional, due to problems with enacting Clause Amendments recognized in Pennsylvania and other states. The defendants improperly inserted the rule, which was not founded on their Fore ^{NFL} fathers and should not take away the touchdown thus sending the Pittsburgh Steelers to the playoffs instead of the San Diego Chargers (NFL Playoffs).

Relief Sought on behalf of Plaintiff, Pittsburgh Steelers Players, Coaches, and Fans:

- A. A Temporary Injunction of 1 week ^{10 days (Football)} of All NFL Playoffs to allow:
 - i. A rekick by Succup ^(chiefs) thus making the Field Goal 37 yards instead of 41 yards. and or coin toss and or
 - ii. Pittsburgh Steelers v San Diego Chargers Match-up on Neutral Site to determine 6th seed
 - iii. Commissioner Goodell ^{Roger}, Defendant allowing this protest due to the fact that Reid could not challenge an obvious error on instant replay; and declare Chiefs winners + Allow Steelers as six seed.
 - iv. and or money damages of excess of \$25,000.00 plus

IFP money on account has less than \$6.00 on account

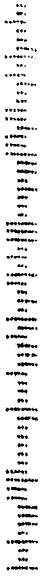
